

Heart City USBC Annual Meeting Minutes

- 1. President Rich Hughey called the meeting to order at 6:36 p.m July 16th, 2020 at Signature Lanes.
- 2. Roll Call of directors: Samantha Hughey, Todd Beaver, Jane Culp, Carl Kelley Jr, Chris Hartung, Conner Batson and Shane Lovely were not present. We have 16 of 25 Directors present.
- 3. Rich provided a review of 2019-20 Season:
 - The following events were cancelled for the 2019-2020 season due to Covid-19. USBC Convention, Open & Women's Championships, Team USA, PWBA season, Intercollegiate Championships, Jr. Gold, State Tournament ended short, State Meeting, State Jamboree. Update: USBC cancelled all National events effective 7/14/2020.
 - After a couple of years of getting new and additional data from lane inspections USBC has suspended the requirements for local associations to conduct annual re-certifications. Going forward USBC will implement a team of inspectors at the national level who will conduct all inspections going forward and work directly with proprietors to do so. A tiered center certification program will be implemented. Centers will be inspected and assigned to a tier based on the level to which it meets USBC specifications. The decision to make any necessary improvements, based on the results of an inspection, will be left to the center and no longer mandated by USBC. This was to be implemented in 2022. With COVID-19 the national inspector program has been delayed until 2023. In the interim we still have our equipment and are available to assist with any issues that develop.
 - USBC's Bowling Technology Study concluded that specification changes are needed to "sustain the playing field both currently and in the future". The new specifications were announced at the USBC Convention in Reno, Nevada in 2018. A new specification has been established for the oil absorption rate of bowling ball cover stocks. Ball manufacturers have been reporting data since 8/1/18 and all new balls must be in compliance by 8/1/2020. This will not take any balls out of competition as current balls are grandfathered in. A specification to eliminate balance holes while increasing static weight allowances goes into effect 8/1/2020. A rule to keep bowlers from changing the static weight (i.e. drilling grip holes deeper) of bowling balls during competition also goes into effect 8/1/2020.
 - Bowlers can't have any extra holes in bowling that they are not using. When bowling with no thumb bowlers are required to mark where their palm is. Also, the board was asked if bowlers who use house balls and are not using one of the holes in the ball are legal. Rich said we would get with USBC and get clarification on that.
 - Fundraisers: We have our Nelson's Chicken Fundraiser coming up on September 26, 2020 at Monteith Tire on Cassopolis street. Chicken will be \$7 and Pit-ta-toes will be \$4. All board members will have tickets available for pre-sale in August. We also will do 50/50 raffles at all tournament squads.
 - Youth tournament: This year the youth tournament was held at Signature Lanes in October & November; we awarded \$1,400 in scholarships. We had 17 teams in 2019-20, which was up from 2017-18 when we had 15. The doubles, singles and all events entries were down; we had 32 doubles in 2018-19 compared to 44 in 2017-18, 64 singles this season compared to 88 in 2017-18 and 61 all-events compared to 88 in 2017-18.
 - The K&W Electric Mixed Tournament took place at Country Club Lanes this year; we saw an increase from 24 teams in 2019 to 27 teams in 2020. CK's Pro Shop will be sponsoring the Mixed Tournament in 2020-21 with Carl Kelley Jr. serving as tournament director
 - Women's Tournament took place in March at Oakland Lanes. We had 10 teams in 2020 compared to 15 in 2019, 12 doubles this
 year compared to 23 last season, 24 singles this year compared to 45 last, 21 all-events compared to 43 last, 11 senior singles this
 year compared to 25 last, and 11 senior all-events compared to 25 last. The tournament was shortened after 2 of 3 weekends
 due to Covid-19.
 - Open Tournament also took place in March at Oakland Lanes. We had 22 teams in 2020 compared to 37 in 2019, 31 doubles compared to 86, 57 singles compared to 150, 43 all-events compared to 144, 18 senior singles compared to 43 and 16 senior allevents compared to 37. The tournament was shortened after 2 of 3 weekends due to Covid-19.
 - Masters tournament which was to be held at Country Club Lanes was cancelled due to Covid-19.
 - Our Hall of Fame and Awards Banquet scheduled for May 2nd was cancelled due to Covid-19. We did still award our
 Outstanding Youth Scholarships. Winners were Katie Fraser, Aaron Huffman, Erica Toops & Joicelynn Messina. Our 2020 Hall
 of Fame inductees are Jim Sanders, Lori Pierce, Dave Swinson and Greg Spinner. They will be recognized at the 2020-21
 banquet.
 - Appointed positions for the 2020-21 season: Carl Slabaugh will continue as the association manager, Chris Clark as the financial recorder and Jessica Hughey as the membership recorder.
- 4. Association Manager Carl Slabaugh presented the following reports.
 - Copies of the minutes from the 2019-20 Annual Meeting were distributed to attendees as they signed in. The board has reviewed them and believe them to be accurate. Carl asked attendees if there are any changes that need to be made? Motion to accept the minutes as presented was made by Duane Lovely and seconded by Barb Ladow. Passed unanimously.
 - Membership trends: Adult membership in 2019-20 was 924 which went down from 964 in 2018-19. Youth membership went down to 163 in 2019-20 from 188 in 2018-19. Our total membership this season was 1,087 compared to 1,152 in 2018-19.
 - Financial Report: The significant deviations from the budget experienced this year were communicated. In summary we anticipate a loss of approximately \$1,015.00. Cash balance is \$17,105 as of 7/7/2020. Final 2019-20 financial report will be published in the yearbook as always. Fiscal year ends July 31, 2020.
 - Any remaining business from the 2019-20 season? None.
 - Quorum Status: We are required to have 35 voting members in attendance in order to conduct elections and vote on any
 proposed bylaw changes. We have 31 voting members in attendance consisting of 16 board members and 15 additional
 members. We DO NOT have a quorum. We will continue with the remaining agenda and then consult with USBC as to the
 status of the meeting given Covid and temporary rules that have been adopted. (See notes below explaining how we will
 handle the business voted on as advised by USBC Regional Director David Prange)
 - Directors election: We have 7 terms that are expiring and 1 removed for lack of participation for a total of 8 open positions. We have 6 repeat applicants (Christel Hughey, Samantha Hughey, Dale Wagoner, Monica Kegerreis, Jane Culp and Larry Tebo.) as well as two new applicants (Dustin and Crystal Schoonover) to fill the 8 open positions. Bev Killarney made a motion to approve the slated candidates which was seconded by Lizzy Glaser. Passed unanimously. (The election cannot stand without a quorum. Since we have the same number of candidates as openings and therefore no disputes, our President will appoint the candidates to the Board after August 1st.)

- With Christel Hughey having served the maximum terms as Vice President the board has slated Mike Killarney as Vice President. Motion was made by Jason Smith to accept Mike as vice president which seconded by Larry Tebo. Passed Unanimously. (This election also cannot stand. Again, with only one candidate and not disputes our President will appoint the candidate after August 1st.)
- Youth Directors: We are required to have 20% of the board to consist of youth. We have two Youth Directors returning—Shane Lovely & Elizabeth Terry. This leaves three open spots to be appointed and approved by the new board of directors. We plan to appoint Raven Sangster which leaves 2 openings as of 7/16/2020 that we will fill as soon as possible.
- We are proposing to amend the annual meeting quorum requirement. This is Bylaw Article 7, section A-7. The current annual meeting quorum requirement is 35 members. We are proposing that the quorum be reduced to 30, as we have struggled to get 35 attendees at our annual meeting in recent years and consequently have been unable to conduct business. Motion to approve was made by Duane Lovely and seconded by Crystal Schoonover. Passed unanimously. (This bylaw change cannot stand as voted on. It was suggested that we propose this again as the first item of business at the next Annual Meeting and that the motion include that it become effective immediately. Since we have brought this up a couple times, have a history of not achieving quorum and the vote that was taken was unanimous, if passed this would become effective immediately and the remainder of the next meeting would be conducted under the new quorum bylaw.)
- We are asking for approval to continue donating to the Marion Veterans Hospital and the All 4 Alice Foundation as we have
 historically done. Motion to approve was made by Greg Spinner and seconded by Barb Ladow. Passed unanimously. (This
 cannot stand as voted. However, since we have a history of receiving approval and making this contribution, at the
 next Board Meeting we will vote on an "Act of the Board" on behalf of the membership to officially approve this
 request.)
- We are asking for approval to send delegates to the ISUSBC BA meeting and the USBC Convention if we choose to do so.
 Motion to approve was made Duane Lovely and seconded by Tim Roeglin. Passed unanimously. . (This cannot stand as voted. However, since we have a history of receiving approval and making this contribution, at the next Board Meeting we will vote on an "Act of the Board" on behalf of the membership to officially approve this request.)
- 2019-20 Tentative Tournament Schedule was presented: Youth Tournament will be at Maple City Bowl on November 7-8, 14-15 2020. Mixed Tournament is at Signature Lanes. We are leaving it up to the tournament director if we change dates from February to October as has been discussed. Open and Women's Tournaments March 6-7, 13-14, 20-21, 2021 at Country Club Lanes. The Masters will be April 24, 2021 at Country Club. The Hall of Fame and Awards Banquet will be in early May at the Matterhorn.
- Due to Covid-19 the Midwest Women's Tournament was cancelled for 2020. It will be rescheduled for the 2021 season. We
 are co-hosting the Midwest Tournament with the St. Joe Valley USBC. The tournament runs from May-June 2021. Jane
 Slabaugh oversees our committee for this tournament.
- Any other new business? None.
- 5. Membership Recorder Jessica Hughey presented the following information.
 - Deadlines: League application forms, sanction cards, and sanction dues must be turned in within 30 days of the league's start date (Rule 102E, 2). Award application forms should be turned in within 20 days of the achievement date (Rule 102E, 5a). Reminder of the USBC rule that final averages must be turned in within 15 days of the league's ending date.
 - Please help ensure that membership cards are being filled out correctly and COMPLETELY including membership ID numbers unless the bowler is new and does not have one. There are several places to find this number—on last year's sanction card, bowl.com and the USBC App. Make sure that these are being filled out legibly. Look over league application forms before turning them in to make sure all required information is filled out—league start, and end dates are important.
 Reminder Heart City USBC requires that your current league rules must be submitted at the beginning of the season with the league application forms. Reminder that the amount of money that is turned in with a membership card must match the total amount that is shown as paid on the card you fill out.
